

FCA US and Chrysler Capital partner to present the Enhanced Courtesy Transportation Program

The Courtesy Transportation Program (CTP) allows vehicles placed into service as of January 21, 2021, to be eligible for consumer incentives on retail and lease contracts, when sold after exiting the program and meeting all eligibility requirements.

PLEASE NOTE:

- » CTP vehicles are not eligible for the Federal Tax Credit
- » Most vehicles sold to consumers will be contracted as NEW, unless otherwise required by state guidelines. This means the process has not changed – submit as new to credit, contract as new and take advantage of the existing new vehicle incentives offered by FCA US and administered by Chrysler Capital.
- » Beginning mileage cannot exceed 7,500 miles on previous demonstrator vehicles, previous high school driver education vehicles and special event vehicles. If the beginning mileage exceeds 500, adjust the residual value down for all miles over 500 by \$0.20 per mile. Jeep, Grand Cherokee Trackhawk, Jeep Wrangler 392, Ram 1500 TRX, Wagoneer and Grand Wagoneer and all SRT® vehicles receive a \$0.40-per-mile residual adjustment.

Retail Applications and Contracts

- » Where state guidelines require dealers to contract a prior CTP vehicle as USED, the following will apply:
 - Applications submitted via Dealertrack or RouteOne must be submitted as USED. CTP VINs submitted as USED will receive new car pricing and eligible incentives as part of the decisioning process in credit.
 - When contracting, dealer will need to mark “USED” on the retail contracts.

Lease Applications and Contracts

- » Current guidelines for lease contracts apply; see [Lease Program Guide](#) for details
- » Where state guidelines require dealers to contract a prior CTP vehicle as USED, the following will apply:
 - Applications submitted via Dealertrack or RouteOne must be submitted as USED. CTP VINs submitted as USED will receive new car pricing and eligible incentives as part of the decisioning process in credit.
 - Applications submitted via the Chrysler Capital Dealer Website must be submitted as NEW until enhancements can be put into place.
 - When contracting, dealer will need to mark “USED” on the lease contracts.
